

## Applying for a visiting researcher scholarship at the CTCC

The CTCC welcomes researchers at all level, including PhD students, postdocs, researchers and faculty members, from around the world to visit the centre and participate in the research activities of the centre. The CTCC will be able to financially assist the visiting researcher, provided the plan for research is of relevance for the activities of the CTCC.

In order to evaluate an application for a visiting researcher scholarship, we kindly ask you to provide us with the following information:

- 1) A brief CV including, if applicable, a list of selected publications that reflects your research profile and interest. For PhD students and postdocs, it may be relevant to also include a half-page summary of your research profile.
- 2) A 1-3 page research proposal for the stay at the CTCC, including also a statement as to why a visit to the CTCC is considered beneficial for the research proposed.
- 3) Suggested length of stay (normally the CTCC supports stays of 1-3 months duration, but both shorter and longer stays can be accepted)
- 4) If applicable: Suggested time period for the visit
- 5) Whether you would be coming with a portable PC or would be in need of being provided with a suitable work station (Linux)
- 6) If known: Preferred host institution (University of Oslo and/or University of Tromø)
- 7) If known: Preferred host researcher

The application is to be submitted as a single pdf file to [stig.eide@chem.uit.no](mailto:stig.eide@chem.uit.no).

The application will be subject to evaluation and approval by the board of senior researchers at the CTCC, and an expected application processing time will be about 1-2 months. The CTCC reserves the right to decline applications based on lack of available resources and/or space in certain time periods.
